(chorus)

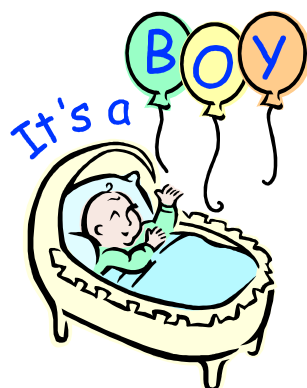
FAMILY MATTERS
