## A WORD FROM BRUCE

### Cast Your Bread Upon The Waters!

I have enjoyed our Wednesday morning Bible Class so much! The Word of God always challenges me in new ways every time I read it, meditate on it and especially as I try to apply it. Ecclesiastes 11:1-6 spoke loud and clear to me last week! The thought is simply, "No Deposit, No Return". Faith isn't always playing it safe! Many times faith is stepping out of the boat like Peter stepped out of the boat. He stepped out only after confirming it was Jesus. Sure he began to sink but Jesus reached out and saved him. The only reason Jesus saved him was due to the fact that he was sinking. The only reason he was sinking was because he took his eyes off Jesus. The reason he stepped out of the boat is because he had his eyes fixed on Jesus. When we have our eyes fixed on Jesus we take risks (from a worldly perspective) for Him. Risks like giving (perhaps more than "expected" or "rational"), befriending folks (not developing clicks), stepping out of comfort zones (using new talents), loving as He intended (completely and without bias), friendship evangelism (not annoyingly but concern), saying I'm sorry and forgive me (from the heart they are signs of maturity), feeding the hungry (not particularly as a church program), clothing those who need it, ... it seems most of the "risks" we take build relationships. Make investments and watch to see how God bless the "risks". However; while "watching to see how God will bless your investment" keep making other investments – diversify!
