David was reared in Cisco, Texas. The Church of Christ in Cisco supported a full-time stateside missionary in the 1980's named Sammy and Mary Flanary. David has been married to their daughter Samantha for 16 ½ years.

David and Samantha attended the Sunset School of Preaching where they were able to be more aware of the Mission of God that God wants all to come to know him. David then attended A.C.U.

where he received a bachelors degree in Finance and

worked in the banking industry as a controller

for Dyess Federal Credit Union. In 2003, David moved to Lubbock to pursue an education degree.

In 2004 he secured a teaching certificate in math and began teaching in Anton, Texas (15 miles west of Lubbock). In 2006, David received a masters degree from Texas Tech in Education and is certified to be a principal. Samantha teaches 1st grade in Anton.

Samantha and David attend the Anton Church of Christ where about 75 saints meet. They are very involved with bible bowl and training the youth of their community for LTC (Leadership Training for Christ) in Dallas each year. This year 29 youths of the Anton community were involved in this ministry.

For the past two summers David has been to Perm, Russia (800 miles east of Moscow) doing mission work at the local church of Christ. This summer David will go to Athens, Greece to teach in the Sunset Branch of preaching school for one month. Samantha will remain at home while their two girls attend summer camps.

David works with Sunset International Bible Institute in Lubbock on a part-time basis speaking to many congregations in West Texas about the need for preacher training. According to a recent study, approximately 25-30% of our brotherhood pulpits are filled with men who have been trained at Sunset. David will be in Athens, Greece teaching at Sunset's Branch school for one month (June 11 to July 7). Currently, he is seeking funds for his teachers apartment rent of \$1,000.00 during his stay.
