YOUTH CORNER

A few weeks ago on a Wednesday night the youth class started a Dave Ramsey video series called Generation Change. We just finished up our 3rd video and have two more videos to go in the series. This has been a great learning experience for our youth.

Every day, our Youth are bombarded with a million different voices, everything from billboards to Internet ads, telling them who they are and measuring their worth by what they have. They are told by these ads, and surprisingly at times by parents, that having jobs and making money are more important than church, God and anything else in their lives. The pressure to be accepted in today's "stuff-centered" world drives them, and perhaps even their parents, to throw money away on things that don't matter, all in an attempt to "be somebody."

Generation Change is an entertaining, informative youth Bible study that shows today's students how money really works, how God views money, and how to grow into responsible young adults who are ready to embrace all of God's blessings. Generation change will help teens understand:

- > Their value through God's eyes
- > That NO amount of "stuff" can change their self-worth
- > The Dangers of debt, from credit cards to car payments
- > Why and how to save money and pay cash for what they want
- > How a lifestyle of generous giving can change the world around them forever

Our next video will deal with "The Gift of Giving". This video will show our young people how important it is to give back to God a portion of what they make and also how important it is to give to others as well. We are challenging our teens that if they have a job this summer to start putting back some of that money for their future and learn how to do a budget and in that budget always allow a portion to go back to God and his church. We believe that this is one of the most important classes that our youth can attend, especially if they have graduated and are going to be on their own, or if they are graduating in the next few years.
