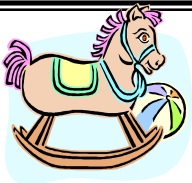

A Word from Bruce

I Corinthians 13

“Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.”

It will be this kind of love that causes you to look past your partner's faults to see the true person. It is this kind of love that seeks the best for your mate no matter what sacrifice you need to make. Jesus demonstrated this love when He gave His life for mankind. This is the kind of love that is needed to make a marriage successful. This love is also demonstrated in **Ephesians 5:22-25 - Wives, understand and support your husbands in ways that show your support for Christ. The husband provides leadership to his wife the way Christ does to his church, not by domineering but by cherishing. So just as the church submits to Christ as he exercises such leadership, wives should likewise submit to their husbands.
