Sometimes we may feel like Lucky! Maybe it doesn't seem that a whole lot of "good things" are going our way. It may feel like a dog-eat-dog world and our legs are made out of milk-bone. Maybe our insecurities of future events control our responses to God and the advancement of His church. Not to be rude or crude but in general that is called having a lack of faith. I believe in being a good steward of the things God has given to us. I hope I am not obsessed with being too cautious like this man ... The Parable of the Rich Fool, Luke 12:13-21. ¹³Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." ¹⁴Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" ¹⁵Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." ¹⁶And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man produced a good crop. ¹⁷He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.' ¹⁸"Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of good things laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry." ' ²⁰"But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' ²¹"This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich toward God."

Some people might think, "Whew! there for a minute I thought he was talking about me! I AM NOT RICH!"

I read something interesting this week that should help us keep our attitude right about how blessed we are by God.
