II Corinthians 9:12-15 - This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of God's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God. Because of the service by which you have proved yourselves, men will praise God for the obedience that accompanies your confession of the gospel of Christ, and for your generosity in sharing with them and with everyone else. And in their prayers for you their hearts will go out to you, because of the surpassing grace God has given you. Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!

The Council of Chalcedon in 451 A.D. Some great minds of the time came together & tried to describe Jesus. Here is their description: "Perfect in Godhead & also perfect in manhood. Truly man of a reasonable, rational soul & body. Consubstantial, co-essential with the Father according to the manhood. In all things like unto us without sin. Begotten before all ages of the Father according to the Godhead. And in these latter times for us & for our salvation, born of the virgin Mary & of the mother of God. According to the manhood - one & the same Christ, Son, Lord, only begotten to be acknowledged in two natures. Inconfusedly, unchangeably, indivisibly, inseparably & the distinction of natures being by no means taken away by the union, but rather the property of each nature being preserved."

Did you understand that? Neither did I. That's man's attempt to describe the indescribable. Even when we bring together our great minds & our most extensive vocabularies, we just scratch the surface in trying to describe Jesus.

Time Line for Elder Selection

- Dec. 20- Begin accepting names of scripturally qualified men to serve as elders;
(you may submit as many names as each individual deems appropriate)
- Jan. 3 - Last day for congregation to submit elder suggestions;
- Jan. 3-16 - Current Elders to interview and qualify potential new elders with no specific number of elders that will be installed until after qualification and interviews;
- Jan. 17 - Announce to congregation the men nominated for installation as elders;
- Jan. 17-31 - Period for congregation to reveal any scriptural reason for the aforementioned men to not be installed as elders.
- Jan. 31 - Install new Elders.
